 - **GENERAL/OBC: 45%**
 - **SC/ST: 40%**
- **AGE LIMIT: NO UPPER AGE LIMIT**

FOR PG (LLM)

- **QUALIFICATION: LL.B. OR EQUIVALENT DEGREE**
- **MINIMUM MARKS:**
 - **GENERAL/OBC: 50%**
 - **SC/ST: 45%**
